

Brand new life member **Mikhail Borodulin** (Russia) filed this fine report:

Mongolia is one of the most exciting destinations in the world for those who are passionate about collecting mountain species. In September 2014, I went on my first expedition to Mongolia. The hunt took place among the ranges of the Altay Mountains in Uvs Province. Due to a tight business schedule, I was able to allocate only

five days for this trip. The plan was to get an Altay argali and promptly return to Moscow. But we mustn't forget that the success of hunting depends 25% on the hunting grounds, 25% on the hunter and 50% luck! And if the first two factors are good, luck is a capricious thing, but this doesn't apply in my case. I reached my goal in the first couple of days by taking an Altay argali of 54". Despite the tight schedule and limited time, I still had enough time to hunt

Altay ibex. As a result I added to my collection a trophy of over 41".

During July 2015, I decided to continue my Mongolia story. In July there was a trip for Hangay argali. My hunt happened, literally, in the tradition of the ancient Romans: "I came, I saw, I conquered." The planned trip duration of seven days ended in two. The result – a great trophy you will see here in the photos. As always, I entrust all of my hunting
