

Ole Augustinus (Denmark) hunted in Azerbaijan during August 2006 for Dagestan (Eastern) tur and scored with two different trophies. Ole sent in this report about that hunt:

When I booked this hunt I was informed that half of the hunting days were stalking and the others would be spent trying to drive the turs against the hunter. From experience I knew that when trying to drive mountain game, a lot of things can happen very suddenly and oftentimes do not give the hunter time enough to judge a trophy! That was exactly what happened to me, so I was happy that I had secured two licenses. On the first day of hunting, two turs came out full speed 150 yards below me. The local guide shouted "shoot," so I fired on the biggest one.

*However, this was an old tur: 12-13 years with very heavy horns, but both horns were missing at least 10". As Azerbaijan is not just around the corner and I was already there, I was happy to have a second license. On the fourth day I took my second tur which also was 12-15 years old and as beautiful as a tur can be. This hunt is very well-organized from arriving to departing Baku. Quartering and food is excellent and **Mirbala Manofov** is the top mountain guide in Azerbaijan with more than 20 years of experience.*
