

Zeev Nederman (TX) decided to hunt the Caucasus Mountains during September and October 2013 and filed this report:

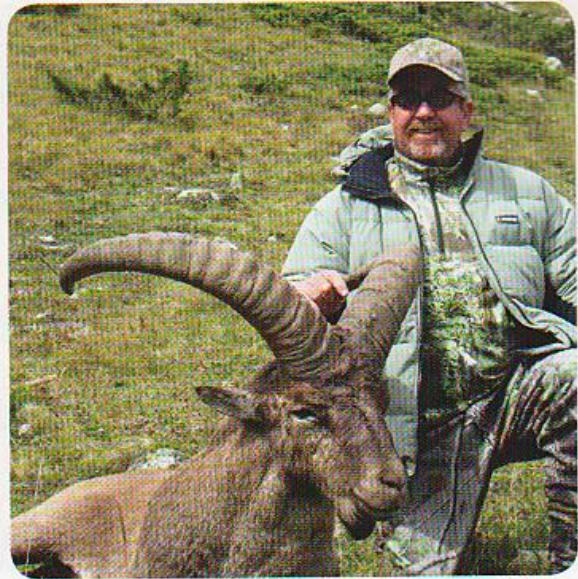
I just returned from a fantastic hunt in Russia with Profihunt. All aspects of the hunt were as good as can be



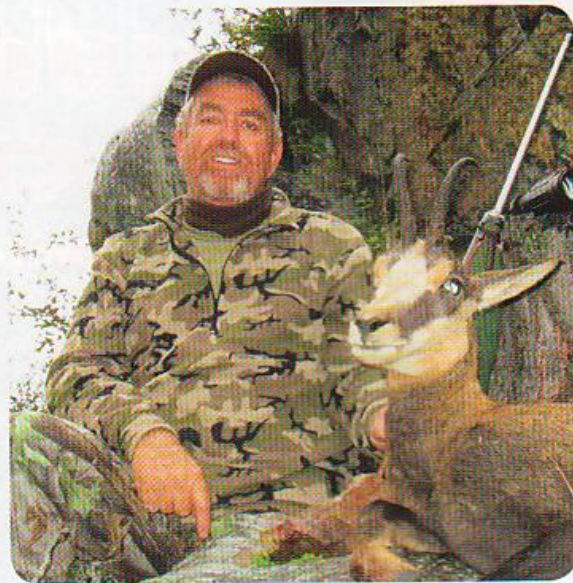

September 24, 2013 – Mid-Caucasian tur in Kabardino-Balkariya Republic of Russia. After an all-day ride to the top of the world we made camp in a windswept little valley and turned in for the night. The next day we observed mostly female and young tur. The next two days it rained and turned to heavy snow with zero visibility. The fifth day we observed a large herd on a parallel ridge. Interestingly, there were three albino tur, but none were trophies. Suddenly I noticed a tur with his head resting on a rock and an unusual shape to his horns... more like a Dagestan tur, the horns were so heavy. The 400-yard shot was good. The animal is very old and one of his horns has been growing into his upper jaw for years.

September 27, 2013 – Kuban (Western) tur in Karachayevo-Cherkesiya Republic of Russia. This animal is over 11 years old. This is a very challenging hunt, as the mountains are very steep. The climb started at 4 a.m. to get above the treeline. As daylight was breaking, the tur were up and going over the ridge. A quick setup for a 485-yard shot resulted a fantastic trophy. The descent of this mountain was very slow and a dangerous one that I will not forget.

October 1, 2013 – Caucasian chamois in Karachayevo-Cherkesiya Republic of Russia. This is an elusive little mountain animal.
